Granger, part of *Forbes* "30 under 30" in 2020, has built up an impressive CV, including a fellowship at the Queens Museum of Art and residencies at the Studio Museum in Harlem and the Skowhegan School of Painting & Sculpture. Granger's *Before I Let Go* was screened at MoMA PS1 and took home Best Experimental Film and the Audience Choice awards at the BlackStar Film Festival in Philadelphia.

Janelle Moorman's documentary and narrative work is largely experimental in nature. Her films have

been screened at the Columbus Moving Image Art Review, Lincoln Theatre (Columbus), *Chroma: Best* of *CCAD*; The Ohio State University's Wexner Center for the Arts, American Psychological Association Film Festival (Chicago), and the AICAD Art & Design Symposium (Los Angeles), as well as at a nonfiction film festival in Paris. Her documentary *Bethany* won a Gold Telly award in the Non-Broadcast Individual Documentary category and was nominated for a student Emmy award.

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
